Teaching

Children's Christian Education

- ◆ **Kids ROCK Teacher** - Teachers begin at 9:00 a.m. or 10:30 a.m. in each of the following age groups: 1st & 2nd grade, 3rd & 4th grade, and 5th grade on a rotating basis.
- ◆ **Kids Rock Worship Music Leader** - Assisting in worship at 9:00 a.m. or 10:30 a.m. with the music for the children.
- ◆ **Cherub Church Teacher** - There are 3 teachers who lead the lessons and activities at 9:00 a.m. or 10:30 a.m., for ages 4-5 yrs. old, & kindergarten on a rotating basis.
- ◆ **Cherub Church Assistant** - There are 3 assistants help lead the lessons and activities at 9:00 a.m. or 10:30 a.m., for ages 4-5 yrs. old, & kindergarten on a rotating basis.
- ◆ **Cherub Church Youth Helper** - Jr. High or older youth helping once a month at 9:00 a.m. or 10:30 a.m. for ages 4-5 yrs. old through kindergarten with the lessons and children.
- ◆ **Kid's Bible Club** - Wednesday evening Christian education as a part of T.G.I.W. for children age 3 through 5th grade.
- ◆ **Vacation Bible School Director & Assistant** - Work with Pastor Gerald Frye in choosing and facilitating the VBS program. They will coordinate volunteers and help choose the program. The Assistant succeeds the Director the following year.
- ◆ **Vacation Bible School Teacher or Helper** - Help with the five day program during the summer for children 3 years old through Junior High.



Youth Christian Education

- ◆ **Co-Sunday School Teacher (Jr. High Youth)** - Teachers needed to lead Sunday morning classes.
- ◆ **Co-Sunday School Teacher (Sr. High Youth)** - Teachers needed to lead Sunday morning classes.
- ◆ **Substitute Teacher** - Fill in for regular teacher in Sunday morning class.
- ◆ **Jr. High Youth Leader/Assistant** - Work with Junior High youth (grades 6 through 8) in areas of Bible study, recreation and special projects. Jr. High Youth meets at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday evenings during the school year and less frequently during the summer. Special activities are scheduled at other times.

- ◆ **Sr. High Youth Leader/Assistant** - Senior high youth (grades 9 through 12) in areas of Bible study, recreation and special projects. Sr. High Youth meets at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday evenings during the school year and less frequently during the summer. Special activities are scheduled at other times.
- ◆ **Youth Ministry Helpers** - Adults who are willing (on an "as needed" basis) to serve as chaperones, help with transportation and food, etc.
- ◆ **Youth Bible Study Leaders** - Lead either a Jr. High or Sr. High Bible Study, separate from Wed or Sun.
- ◆ **Confirmation Class Mentor** - A mentor is a spiritual guide, one who understands and communicates to those less advanced in the faith.
- ◆ **Confirmation Class Helper** - Confirmation is held at 9:00 a.m. during the school year. Help is needed with administering the program.

Adult Christian Education

- ◆ **Adult Christian Education Teacher** - Leading a class, Bible study, or other adult educational opportunity. May be a regular or special event.
- ◆ **Substitute Teacher** - Fill in for regular teacher in Sunday morning class.

Administration

- ◆ **Leadership Council** - The leadership body of the church that partners with the pastors to set vision and direction for the church.
- ◆ **Recording Secretary** - Attend the meetings of the Council and all Church/Charge conferences, recording the proceedings.
- ◆ **Church Stewardship and Finances** - helping direct and maintain a Christlike view of our resources.
- ◆ **Personnel Development and Relations**— Staffing for effective ministry is an important part of our church.
- ◆ **Buildings and Grounds**— The building and grounds support the ministry of the church by providing attractive and appropriate facilities.
- ◆ **Volunteer Development & Support**— With hundreds of people involved at Shiloh, we help people connect with their gifts and passion.
