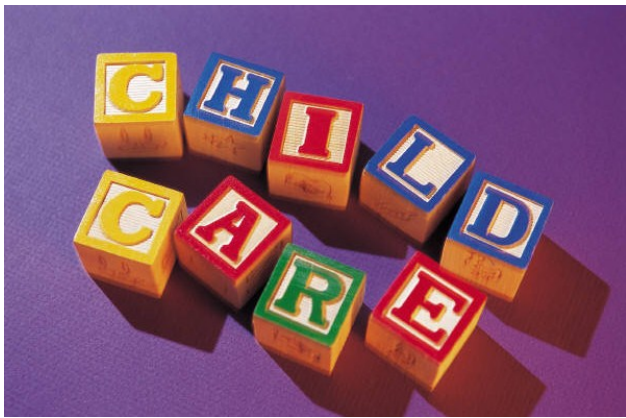
Sisters in Christ Lunch

EARLY RESPONSE TEAM

UMCOR is the humanitarian relief and development agency of the United Methodist Church. UMCOR's mission is to alleviate human suffering. ERT teams are dispatched by UMVIM, which exists to promote "Christian Love In Action."

DEFINITION of a **DISASTER**: A disaster is any specific event which results in overwhelming physical economic and/or emotional damage to a community.

PHASES of a **DISASTER**: **1.** Preparation Phase (no ERT Response at this point) **2.** Response Phase (Relief response to assist home owners).

WHAT DO EARLY RESPONSE TEAMS DO: **1.** Provide a Christian presence **2.** Take steps to prevent further damage to a family's personal property- stabilize). **3.** Teams may be asked to manage donated materials. **4.** Observe survivor's needs and report these to the local operations. **5.** Be a part of the caring ministry of "listeners" who will help the survivor begin to heal.

UMCOR suggests that the church have a pool of 30 trained volunteers of which 7-14 may be called to assist in an emergency.
