Spiritual Growth

- ◆ **Small Group Ministry** - In the tradition and spirit of John Wesley, the founder of Methodism, we are called to share with one another, be accountable to one another, and walk on our journey of life together.

Helping

- ◆ **Van Ministry** - The scope of this ministry will involve picking up people for our worship services on Sunday mornings and driving the vehicle for other needed activities.
- ◆ **Communication**— within Shiloh and outside, P.R., bulletin boards, etc.
- ◆ **Set up/Tear down/Moving stuff around** - Preparing the tables for worship, i.e. Bibles, bulletins, etc. As well as setting tables up when necessary.
- ◆ **Mowing & Trimming** - Someone willing to be put on a rotating schedule, with others, to mow and trim the church grounds/landscaping.
- ◆ **General Help**— lending a hand from time to time, when something needs done.
- ◆ **Office Help** - Help with mailings and other clerical duties as needed.

Fellowship/Relational

- ◆ **Turkey Dinner** - Volunteers are needed in many different areas, preparing food, waiting tables, set-up/tear down, advertising, ticket sales and much much more!
- ◆ **J.O.Y. (Just Older Youth)** - a senior fellowship group that shares in common interests and stage of life.
- ◆ **Special 1-Time Events**— Shiloh hosts and ministers through many one-time events throughout the year, and help is always needed.

Peer Support

- ◆ **Stephen's Ministries** - Sometimes a listening ear and a kind heart can help us get through the tough times. Stephen's ministries help us to help each other—person to person.
